Friends have been asking what we are in need of...If I can re-stock my studio and get back to work, we will be just fine. I am continuing to prepare for my Artist in Residency at the NAEEA Distinguished Fellows Leadership Institute in Maine next summer and have much work to do. Simply bring your wonderful self and help us turn the page on this disaster. For those who have asked for suggestions, the following is a list of some things that were lost in the fire:

Tools....putty knives, screwdrivers, paint brushes of all kinds, bags of rags and mattress pads for protecting sculpture and paintings, plastic mixing bowls of all sizes, hammers and saws, wrenches and pliers, tape measures, nail punches, all variety of screws and nails, tie wire and tape, electrical pliers and wire caps, rope and bungee cords, screw eyes and tacks, gorilla glue, epoxy, glue guns and glue sticks both large and small, clamps, staple guns and staples, sandpaper, saw horses, crow bars, post hole digger, shovels, brooms and rakes, loppers and clippers, wire cutters, power cords all lengths and multi-plug power bars, any cement tools, work gloves and rubber gloves all large ... *really, I can use virtually any tool at all to begin again.*

Resource Materials...figurines of all kinds (both human and animal, and plants) to be re-purposed in the obelisk series "Seduction and Scorchmarks," orphan earrings, broken bracelets, watches and clocks, keys and old fashioned locks and hardware, broken eyeglasses, fabric and fur, lace and yarn, canvas yardage, feathers, doll parts and doll furniture, interesting bones and bags of stones, broken granite and marble pieces, shells, handbags and wallets for the "Spending Time" series (see website: englestudio.com), old upright vacuums for the "Nature Abhors a Vacuum" series (See website), glass chunks and beads, fiberglass resin and fabric, clear spray lacquer, chains and necklaces...*whatever you might be ready to pass on into the next series, "Burnt Offerings."*
